



What is Whittier Pony Baseball?

SHETLAND DIVISION: Ages 4, 5 and 6. Is based on the participation of as many youths in the age group as possible with an emphasis on fun. Play is with safety t-ball and all players are rotated to guarantee maximum playing time on the field.

PINTO DIVISION: Ages 7 and 8. Intended to teach the fundamentals of baseball by the simplest method possible; letting them play the game. Emphasis is on instruction, not the league championship. Players are rotated to guarantee maximum playing time on the field.

MUSTANG DIVISION: Ages 9 and 10. Players play real baseball. Mustang permits players to pitch three innings. Lead offs and base stealing are permitted. The game is played on a diamond with a 60 foot base path. Most of the rules are similar to Major League Baseball.

BRONCO DIVISION: Ages 11 and 12. Players are taught the entire game of baseball on 70-foot bases and a 48 foot pitching mound. If you don't think 11 & 12 year old players are capable of playing the complete game of baseball, you are encouraged to see a Bronco division game.

PONY DIVISION: Ages 13 and 14. This division is best described as a transition program between youth and young adult baseball. Pony is the division specifically designed for the player in the formative teen years.
